First, an independent third party analyses what chemicals are used in a product. After detecting what components are present, these are compared with a list of substances harmful to people and the environment. This is followed by a chemical hazard risk assessment. The product's certification level is based on the extent of its compliance with various predefined criteria. To improve and achieve a higher certification level, undesirable substances must be replaced. That is how the Original Microfibre Cloth obtained the Bronze Level. It is Greenspeed's ambition to keep innovating in order to reach a higher level in the future.
